IS IT NEEDED TO KNOW ABOUT ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT


- Public awareness is the best way to keep environment in its original form.

- Continuous research on solving environmental problems.



POPULATION

- Existing agricultural lands are polluted with insecticides and fertilizers.


DEFORESTATION
